**RULE 1.0015
WHERE TO FILE DOCUMENTS**

I. Geographical Regions

In all actions and special proceedings in which the alleged cause of action occurred or the subject matter of the action is located in the geographical area of the Western Region, Mid County Region or Desert Region of the Riverside County Superior Court as defined below, the documents initiating the action or special proceeding shall be filed in the relevant region at the courthouse specified below. Except for documents pertaining to appeals, all subsequent documents related to that action or special proceeding shall also be filed in the specified courthouse within that region. Documents pertaining to appeals shall be filed as specified in Part VII of this rule.

Self-represented litigants may visit a self-help center at any court location in the county for assistance in filing documents at the proper courthouse.

Actions and proceedings shall usually be heard in the courthouse in which they were filed or in another courthouse in the same region. For good cause, and to maximize efficient use of court resources, actions or proceedings may also be assigned for hearings in other regions.

II. Civil

A. Unlimited Civil

1. Petitions for restraining orders pursuant to Code of Civil

Procedure sections 527.6, 527.7, and 527.8

a. Western Region

- i. VI. Probate, Adoptions, and Mental Health

A. Proceedings under the Probate Code, Petitions for Freedom from Parental Custody and Control under Family Code section 7800 et seq., or Adoptions under Family Code section 8500 et seq.

1. The Western Region consists of the communities of Alberhill, Arlington, Canyon Lake, Casa Blanca, Corona, Corona Hills, Edgemont, El Cerrito, Glen Avon, Glenn Valley, Highgrove, Home Gardens, Homeland, La Sierra, Lake Elsinore, Lakeland Village, Lakeview, Mead Valley, Meadowbrook, Menifee, Mira Loma, Moreno Valley, Murrieta, Murrieta Hot Springs, Norco, Nuevo, Pedley, Perris, Quail Valley, Riverside, Romoland, Rubidoux, Santa Ana Canyon, Sedco, Sun City, Temecula,

Temescal Canyon, Vail Lake, West Riverside, and Wildomar.

- a. All documents concerning Guardianship actions or proceedings that arise out of the Western Region communities shall be filed at the Riverside Family Law Courthouse.
- b. All documents concerning Petitions for Freedom from Parental Custody and Control, Adoptions, and Probate actions or proceedings other than Guardianships that arise out of the Western Region communities shall be filed at the Riverside Historic Courthouse.

2. Mid County Region

All documents concerning actions or proceedings that arise out of the communities of Aguanga, Anza, Gilman Hot Springs, Hemet, Mountain Center, Pine Cove, Redec, Sage, San Jacinto, Soboba Hot Springs, Valle Vista, or Winchester shall be filed at the Hemet Courthouse.

3. Desert Region

All documents concerning actions or proceedings that arise out of the communities of Banning, Beaumont, Bermuda Dunes, Blythe, Cabazon, Calimesa, Cathedral City, Cherry Valley, Coachella, Desert Center, Desert Hot Springs, Eagle Mountain, Highland Springs, Idyllwild, Indian Wells, Indio, La Quinta, Mecca, North Shore, Oasis, Palm Desert, Palm Springs, Pinyon Pines, Poppet Flatt, Rancho Mirage, Ripley, Salton Sea, Silent Valley, Thermal, Thousand Palms, or Whitewater shall be filed at the Indio Annex.

B. Proceedings under Division 5, Part 1 of the Welfare and Institutions Code (Mental Health)

All documents concerning actions or proceedings that arise out of all communities countywide shall be filed at the Riverside Historic Courthouse.

VII. Appeals

Regardless of the region or courthouse in which the judgment or appealable order was issued:

- A. In all appeals to the Court of Appeal, all notices of appeal and

documents concerning the designation and preparation of the record shall be filed at the Hall of Justice in Riverside.

B. In all appeals to the Appellate Division of the Riverside County Superior Court, all notices of appeal and all subsequent documents shall be filed at the Hall of Justice in Riverside.

C. Infractions

All notices of appeal and all subsequent documents shall be filed at the courthouse in which the judgment was issued.

VIII. Writs of Habeas Corpus

All documents concerning petitions for writs of habeas corpus arising anywhere in the county shall be filed at the Hall of Justice in Riverside.
