## What costs am I responsible for?

If you are the minor, you are responsible for:

- Fines
- Victim Restitution
- Administrative Fees

If you are the parent(s) or other person(s) responsible for the minor, you are responsible for:

- Fines
- Victim Restitution
- Administrative Fees
- Detention Costs
- Attorney Fees
- Clothing Allowance

Each person(s) is responsible for the full amount until it is paid.

## What do you mean “Attorneys’ Fees”?

The fee for county legal services rendered to the minor pursuant to an order of the Juvenile court.

(Sect 903.1 of Welfare and Institutions Code)

## What are Detention Costs?

The reasonable costs of support for a minor placed, detained in, or committed to any institution or other place according to an order of the Juvenile Court.

(Section 903 of the welfare and Institutions Code)

## If you were ordered to pay Victim Restitution

- Please respond immediately to the letter you will receive when the amount of restitution is established.

## Court Administration Fee

Fee assessed for processing of monthly payments.

(Penal code 1205d)
