JJCDPC AUTHORIZATION TO INSPECT
JUVENILE PLACEMENT FACILITIES


The Riverside County Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission is hereby authorized to inspect any and all Riverside County juvenile placement facilities, as well as any private group home or placement facility, wherein minors are present pursuant to a Riverside County Juvenile Court placement order. (Welf. & Inst. Code, §229.) All such facilities, county or private, are ordered to cooperate in allowing the inspection. The purpose of the inspection is to ensure the health and safety of the minors who reside in said placement.

If the JJCDPC is refused entrance into a facility, JJCDPC may move the court for an order to compel the facility to allow an inspection. JJCDPC must give notice to the facility refusing entrance that JJCDPC is requesting a court order to allow an inspection. The court shall set the matter on calendar and hold a hearing to allow both sides to be heard by the court.

This order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of this court.
