) MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED
) TO MINORS IN JUVENILE HALL AND
) ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH RECORDS


The court hereby issues a standing order authorizing the Probation Department to request mental health services for minors detained in or committed to juvenile hall. Mental health services include, but are not limited to, psychological and psychiatric evaluations and treatment. (Fam. Code, §6924(b); Welf. & Inst. Code, §§ 210, 739; 15 Cal. Code Regs. §1437.)

The court further orders that probation officers and the assigned Riverside County mental health care provider may disclose and exchange mental health care information related to the diagnosis or treatment of a minor's mental health condition if the health care provider determines that disclosure is reasonably necessary for the purpose of coordinating the treatment and care of the minor. (Civ. Code, §§ 56.10(c)(20), 56.103(e)(1) ["CMIA"]; 45 C.F.R. §§164.502(a)(1), 164.502(g)(3), 164.512(e) ["HIPAA"].) The nature and extent of information shared shall be appropriate to the treatment planning, program needs, protection of the minor and others, management of the facility, maintenance of security, and preservation of safety and order. (15 Cal. Code, Regs. §1407.)

The assigned health care provider is ordered not disclose to any probation officer information related to treatment to which the minor consented or could have consented on his/her

1 own behalf or where the health care provider determines that access to records would have a
2 detrimental effect on the provider's professional relationship with the minor or the minor's
3 physical safety or psychological well-being. (Civ. Code, §56.103(h) [CMIA]; Fam. Code,
4 §6924(b); Health & Saf. Code, §123115; 45 C.F.R. §160.203(b) ["HIPAA"].)
