Reminder:

(a) Civil Mediation Panelists are required to accept a minimum of three (3) Title 3, Division 2 "court-ordered mediations" per year at \$150 for the first three (3) hours of each mediation.

(b) DRS members who received the Straus Institute training in Feb/March 2009 have agreed to waive the \$150 payment for these three (3) mediations during their first year on the Civil Mediation Panel.

(c) Civil Mediation Panelists who received the reduced-cost Straus Institute training in November 2008 or Feb/March 2009 have agreed to provide ten (10) Title 3, Division 2 "court-ordered mediations" and to waive the \$150 payment for each mediation. After providing these ten (10) mediations, these panelists are in category (a) above.
