Riverside Superior Court Welcomes Judicial Appointees Koosed, Fisher, and Freer

Riverside County: The Riverside County Superior Court is pleased to announce that on Friday, June 22, 2007, Governor Schwarzenegger appointed Charles J. Koosed, Marc R. Fisher, and Timothy F. Freer to judgeships in the court. The three appointees were among the first to be named as new judges under Senate Bill 56, which allocated funds for additional needed judgeships statewide.

Judge Charles Koosed, who will take his oath of office on June 25, has served as a commissioner for the court since 2005, most recently presiding over Juvenile Court matters. Previously, he was an attorney in private practice in Indio from 1994 to 2005. Judge Koosed earned a Juris Doctorate degree from Southwestern School of Law in Los Angeles and a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of California, Los Angeles.

Judge Timothy Freer, who has served as a deputy district attorney with the Riverside County District Attorney's Office since 1989, will take his oath on July 9, 2007. Prior to joining the District Attorney's Office, he was a deputy district attorney with the Ventura County District Attorney's Office from 1987 to 1989. He earned a Juris

Doctorate degree from McGeorge School of Law at University of the Pacific in Stockton and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Marquette University in Wisconsin.

Judge Mac Fisher has been an attorney with the Riverside firm of Bonnie Moss and Associates since 1998, specializing in insurance claims. Previously, he was an associate with the firm of Fisher, Weathers and Geeting from 1984 to 1998 and an associate with the firm of Thompson and Colegate from 1980 to 1984. Judge Fisher earned a Juris Doctorate from Western State University College of Law in Fullerton and a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of California, Riverside. Judge Fisher will take his oath on July 22, 2007.
