

) ORDER RE: JUVENILE WARRANTS

The court hereby issues a standing order that any adult arrested on a no-bail misdemeanor or felony juvenile warrant shall not be released on a citation to appear, but instead shall be detained in a secure county facility pending a detention hearing in juvenile court. (Welf. & Inst. Code, §§ 607(e), 663.)

In all other cases, when parties have either reached the age of 18 or the dependency or wardship has been terminated, the outstanding bench warrants and protective custody warrants are ordered recalled and quashed.
