
) ORDER GRANTING DEFENSE  
) INVESTIGATORS ACCESS TO CLIENTS  
) IN CUSTODIAL FACILITIES

Juvenile defense attorneys, which include public defenders, juvenile defense panel attorneys, and private counsel, employ agents to assist these attorneys in juvenile cases. These agents may include experts, social workers, paralegals, and investigators.

The court finds that it is necessary for these agents to have access to their clients in jail, prison, private drug or alcohol rehabilitation facility, or any other residential facility, so that they may assist counsel in preparing the legal representation of the client.

The court orders that the attorneys' agents shall have access to their clients in jail, prison, private drug or alcohol rehabilitation facilities, or other custodial facility to the greatest extent possible, taking into account the operational needs of the facility.
