If your trial does not begin within that time period, and good cause for the delay is not shown to the court, then the court must order your case dismissed. If you are requesting a trial date beyond the forty-five (45) day limit, you will be giving up your right to a speedy trial. If you **do not** want to give up this right, do not initial this waiver. Your request for postponement may be denied due to time restraints within the forty-five (45) day period if you do not agree to give up your right to a speedy trial.
