California Rules of Court 3.1380 and 3.1385

- Persons required to attend the MSC – CRC, Rule 3.1380(b)
- Settlement Conference Statements – CRC, Rule 3.1380 (c)
- Duty to notify court and others of settlement before MSC – CRC, Rule 3.1385
- Sanctions may be imposed pursuant to CRC, Rule 2.30; CCP §§ 128.5 – 128.7; 177.5; and 575.2.

If the case fully settles before the MSC: Notify the MSC clerk by email and file the Notice of Settlement immediately. See CRC, Rule 3.1385. If notice filed, no need to appear at the MSC.

Continuances: Notify the MSC clerk by email immediately, preferably at least five (5) days before the scheduled MSC date. Review the above MSC Schedule and email the MSC clerk with three (3) proposed dates/time agreed upon by all required MSC participants.

Telephonic Appearances: Telephone appearances are only permitted for out-of-state claims representatives and parties.
