RIVERSIDE COUNTY:

The Judges of the Superior Court have nominated 30 Riverside County citizens to the panel from which the members of the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury will be drawn. Exercising an option available under amended statutes, the judges have named among the 30-member panel, ten members of the 2019-2020 Civil Grand Jury as “holdovers” to the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury. The remaining members, including alternates, for the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury will be drawn on August 28, 2020.

In making judicial nominations to the panel, the court attempted to apportion the panel on the basis of gender, race, age and residency in supervisorial districts to the extent possible from among the applications received.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury nominees will attend a special remote session of the Superior Court to be held at 12:15 p.m. on Friday, August 28, 2020. At this time, the names of the individuals who will serve on the 2020-2021 Civil Grand Jury will be drawn.
