Riverside Superior Court Maintains Its Rules Regarding Face Coverings and Physical Distancing in Courthouses

On November 30, 2020, the California Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board (CalOSHB) issued *Covid-19 Prevention - Emergency Temporary Standards* which require employers to implement certain safety measures including face coverings and physical distancing in shared common areas and workspaces. Courts are, at a minimum, subject to the CalOSHB regulations which remain in effect until further notice.

To ensure the health and safety of all court users – including members of the public, jurors, judicial officers, and court staff – the Riverside Superior Court continues to require that all persons in court facilities adhere to existing safety protocols, including face covering and physical distancing requirements, as outlined in <u>General Order 2020-67</u>.

The court continues to monitor and evaluate Covid-19 rules and regulations issued by various federal, state, and local agencies involved and will update court safety protocols as appropriate.
