RE: RESCISSION OF COURT HOLIDAYS FOR PURPOSES OF COMPUTING TIME FOR FILING PAPERS IN UNLAWFUL DETAINER CASES | GENERAL ORDER NO.: 2020-53

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 10.603, and as set forth in General Order No.: 2020-52, paragraph 1, the Presiding Judge orders as follows:

Effective September 2, 2020, the court rescinds the declaration in General Order No. 2020-52 setting forth certain days as court holidays for the purposes of computing time for filing papers under Code of Civil Procedure §§12 and 12a, as to unlawful detainer filings. Consistent with the COVID-19 Tenant Relief Act of 2020 and any other applicable law, all unlawful detainer filings will be accepted and filed. Documents may be submitted online via the eSubmit Document Submission Portal, by mail, or by placement in the drop box.
