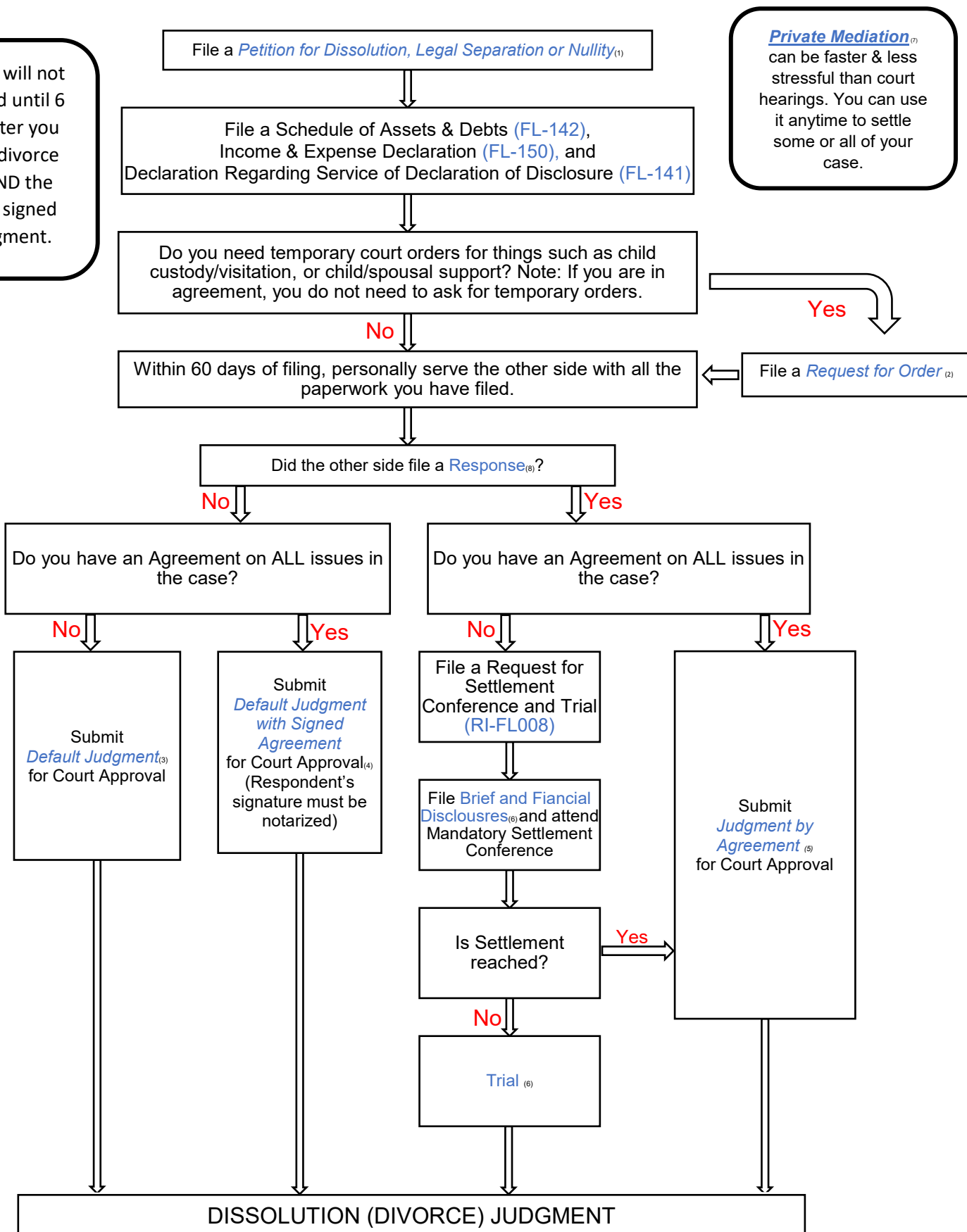


Divorce Case Flow Chart

This chart shows the basic outline of a divorce case. Please consult with an attorney for legal advice concerning your individual case. NOTE: You will not be divorced until 6 months after you serve the divorce papers AND the Judge has signed your Judgment.

Private Mediation⁽⁷⁾ can be faster & less stressful than court hearings. You can use it anytime to settle some or all of your case.
