For good cause, and pursuant to the authority set forth in this Court's General Order 2020-20, Re: Essential Functions, Code of Civil Procedure section 128, and California Rules of Court, Emergency Rule 1, by order of the Presiding Judge, the Court makes the following order:

Limited civil trials, including unlawful detainers, are continued for a period of sixty (60) days from the date of this order.
