
GENERAL ORDER NO.: 2020-71

Pursuant to the authority granted by the March 30, 2020 Statewide Emergency Order issued by Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California (Statewide Order), which the Riverside Superior Court (Court) implemented in its General Order issued on April 1, 2020, and which has been in effect since that time, the Court hereby confirms the authority of any judge to extend the time period provided by Penal Code section 859b for the holding of a preliminary examination from 10 court days to not more than 30 court days.

This order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court, or upon rescission or modification of the Statewide Order.
