

12 TWENTY-THIRD IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF  
13 AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115

14 On March 17, 20, and 23, 2020; April 1, and 24, 2020; May 26, 2020; June 2 and 23, 2020;  
15 July 21 and 29, 2020; August 14 and 19, 2020; September 17 and 28, 2020, October 15 and 30,  
16 2020, November 11, and 24, 2020, December 9 and 17, 2020, January 7, 2021, February 1, 2021,  
17 and March 1, 2021, and upon the request of the Riverside Superior Court (“Court”), Chief Justice  
18 Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, exercising the authority  
19 granted under Government Code section 68115, issued emergency orders (“Orders”) authorizing  
20 the Court to take certain actions pursuant to Government Code section 68115.

21 On March 29, 2021, upon further request made by the Court on March 26, 2021, Chief  
22 Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye issued an additional emergency order authorizing the Court to take  
23 certain actions based on the determination that the conditions described in Government Code  
24 section 68115(a) continue to exist.

25 This Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 26 1. The Court may order that sessions be held anywhere in the county, including in  
27 correctional and juvenile detention facilities, from March 31, 2021, to April 27,  
28 2021, inclusive, (Gov. Code, §68115(a)(1));
