

V. Magaña

- 1) The relative, foster parent or NREFM must receive explicit approval from the social worker to travel with the dependents outside the county;
- 2) The travel must be limited to the continental United States;
- 3) The purpose of travel may include vacation or other legitimate and prudent reasons, placement of dependents in vacation camps or other vacation facilities, or other vacation arrangements without the presence of relative/foster parents;
- 4) The travel period may not exceed 30 days.

1 The exceptions to this standing order are:

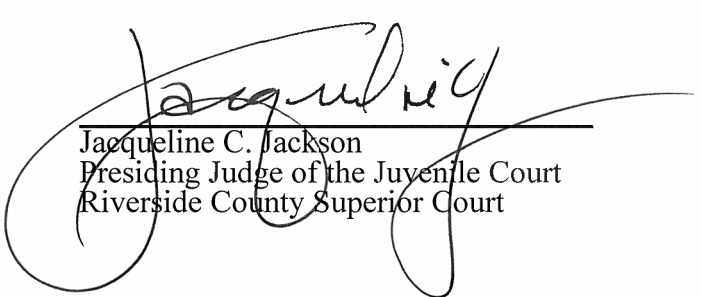
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- 3 1) Children are not to miss scheduled visits with parents;
- 4 2) Children are not to miss school without a specific court order;
- 5 3) Verbal or written notice shall be provided to the parents through their attorney.
