AUTHORIZATION FOR WARDS TO PARTICIPATE IN INDEPENDENT LIVING SKILLS TRIPS AND ACTIVITIES

Riverside County Department of Social Services has received a federal grant to provide independent living skills instruction, training and related programs. The program serves minors ordered by the court into placement who (1) qualify under the grant guidelines, and (2) are 16 to 21 years of age. The program includes participation in age-appropriate activities and camps to assist minors and nonminor dependents to acquire emancipation skills.

Foster parents of dependents with whom the Riverside County Juvenile Court has ordered into placement are authorized to allow wards to participate in Independent Living Skills Programs sponsored trips, camps, and activities if qualified under grant guidelines and are between 16 to 21 years of age. (42 U.S.C. §675; Welf. & Inst. Code §§ 303, 362.05, 16001.9(a)(13), 11400(v) & (w), 11401; 22 Cal. Code Regs. §§ 83072(c)(20), (23), 84072(c)(25), (28), 89379.)
