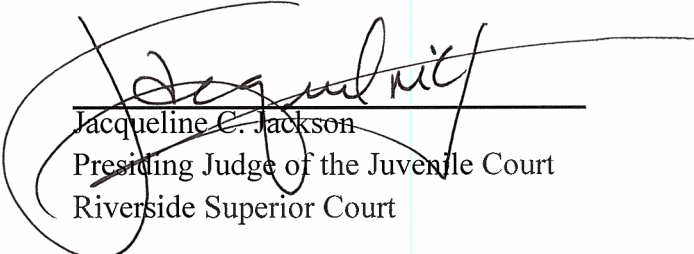

RELEASE OF JUVENILE COURT
RECORDS TO RIVERSIDE COUNTY
MENTAL HEALTH LIAISON

The Riverside County Department of Mental Health has assigned a mental health professional to assist the Riverside County juvenile court with respect to mental health issues, among them- providing clinical information regarding diagnosis and treatment, making recommendations for appropriate mental health programs, determining availability of programs and making referrals, assessing minors' success in treatment programs, providing minors' mental health history, and following up with families and programs to ensure participation.

Confidentiality rules allow agencies providing treatment to inspect juvenile court records. (Welf. & Inst. Code, §827(a)(1)(K)& (P); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 5.552(b)(2)(A).)

In order to assist the juvenile court with mental health issues, the juvenile court hereby issues a standing order authorizing the Riverside County probation department to allow the Riverside County mental health liaison to review juvenile court reports and other pertinent information found within the juvenile case file. (Civ. Code, §§ 56.10 (b)(1) &(c)(20), 56.103(a) & (e)(1) ["CMIA"]; 45 C.F.R. §§164.502(a)(1), 164.502(g)(3), 164.512(e) ["HIPAA"]; Welf. & Inst. Code, §739.]
